

The USGS Forest and Rangeland Ecosystem Science Center seeks a new Center Director. This is a science administration position within the Biological Resources Discipline of USGS, stationed in Corvallis Oregon. The closing date for applications is August 22.

The selectee will be responsible for the management of a broad, multi-disciplinary program of biological research, inventory and monitoring, and information management. As a member of the Regional Biologist's senior management team, the selectee will be responsible for the planning, coordination and implementation of natural resource partnerships with States, other Federal agencies, academic institutions, and private groups interested in the status and management of biological resources.

Position grade is GS-15 (\$92K - \$120K/yr)
