

Field Botanists Needed

Eagle Cap Consulting Inc. is looking for field botanists and a botanical crew supervisor to work on a project in Southwest Idaho along the Snake River. The work will involve characterizing upland and riparian plant communities, as well as possibly conducting surveys for rare plants and noxious weeds. The positions will last from approximately May 1 until August 15, 2005. The crews will work 10 hour days with an 8-day-on/6-day-off schedule. A per diem allowance will cover all lodging and meals during the working days.

A combination of formal botanical training and related field experience is required. Ideally, a Bachelor's degree in botany with one season (or more) of botanical field experience in western North America is preferred, but we will consider all applicants on an individual basis.
